GSM Blend - (35%) Grenache / (35%) Shiraz / (30%) Mourvedre

REGION

S.E. Australia

COLOR

Deep Garnet / Burgundy

BOUQUET

Spicy, sweet berry fruits mix with soft overtones of French oak and raspberries.

PALATE

A rich forward palate of spicy berry fruits leads to a round mid-palate with some dark blackberry and raspberry characters evident. This finely textured wine has a savory elegance balanced by soft tannins.

PAIRINGS

Grilled steak teriyaki, lasagne, and pork or chicken dishes.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Grenache & Mourvedre sourced from the famous Claire Valley in South Australia were artfully blended with Shiraz from the "Gentle Annie" vineyard in Cenral Victoria in this classic "Rhone Style" red blend. Matured in French oak, this wine shows deep concentration evident from the 2007 drought conditions.
